Poetry

- Recite “Little Miss Muffet” (*Flip Chart, page 26*) aloud as class for the final review.
- Allow students to recite or sing poem.
- Celebrate those who have memorized the poem.

Grammar and Mechanics

- Review prepositions. Reference the list in the *Tools* folder.
- Find one in the poem: (beside)
- Use prepositions to describe where else a spider might land!

Phonics

- Name all the animals you can think of that begin with s: snakes, salamander, salmon, scorpion, slug, snail, skunk, squid, stork, swan, swallow, etc.
- Sort the animals by category (mammal, bird, reptile, fish) or into two lists: what you would like to land beside you and what you would not.

Writing

- Chorally read the paragraph the class created yesterday.
- Model how to use the 4-Point Check (*Flip Chart, page 20*) to edit your work.
- Underline one -ly adverb in the paragraph.

Copy Work

- Distribute **Student Handout 17.7**. Read the sentence.
- Invite students to complete copy work and illustrate.
- Students should file the source text (SH 17.3) behind the Source Text tab in their Student Writing Portfolio and today’s poetry copy work (SH 17.7) behind the Finished Work tab.
